Dibner has the right to include or remove the Contribution from the Program, to translate the Contribution into English, to edit the Contribution so long as no material changes are made to the substance of the Contribution, to include abstracts of the Contribution in the Program, and to include links from the Contribution to other parts of the Program Site and other related web sites and from these sites to the Contribution.

Dibner, and related participants in the Program, have the right to copy, transcribe, photograph, electronically scan, or record the Contribution, as appropriate, as may be reasonably necessary to exercise the above license.

Dibner will include the appropriate citation to the Grantor when using the Contribution.

The Grantor understands that the Program Site will be accessible throughout the world, and that the Contribution may be subject to comment by other users of the Program Site.
